# QCCIFD Meeting Minutes – January 22, 2025

The Queen Creek County Island Fire District (QCCIFD) governing board met in a properly posted open public meeting on Wednesday, January 22, 2025. The meeting was held at the Town of Queen Creek – Town Hall Meeting Room – San Tan Conference room, located at 22358 S. Ellsworth Road, Queen Creek, Arizona.

The following agenda items were considered at the meeting:

- A. The meeting of the QCCIFD board was called to order at 6:32 p.m. by chair Kuefner.
- B. Roll Call: Chairman Kuefner, Clerk Holthouse and member Doyle in attendance. (Absent - Ruscetti) Additional attendees: Chief Gray and Chief Marlar and Kelly Vaughn – Administrative Manager and John Flynn (consultant – attended telephonically)

**Item 1:** Consideration of approval of the governing board meeting minutes of November 20, 2024 (QCCIFD #25-001):

Motion by Kuefner /  $2^{nd}$  by Holthouse: To approve the November 20, 2024 minutes; Passed 3-0. (Ruscetti – Absent)

**Item 2:** Call to the Public:

There were members of the public that were in attendance. There were questions regarding a potential boundary change.

**Item 3:** Report from the fire chief regarding the provision of fire and EMS to the QCCIFD, including but not limited to the following items (QCCIFD #25-n/a):

Monthly response and service report: Chief Marlar discussed the November and December response reports. There was 1 structure fire in December. The average response time was a little over 5 minutes.

Discussion only – no action taken.

**Item 4:** Consideration and possible action concerning future potential boundary change to the QCCIFD. (QCCIFD #25-002).

There was a discussion only regarding the boundary change which was led by John Flynn, Chief Gray and Chief Marlar.

# ARS Title 48, Chapter 1, Article 10 - §48-262

### **Pre-Boundary Change Hearing Tasks**

- 1. Person(s) proposing to change district boundaries provide legal description to county assessor for parcel data within proposed area for annexation.
- 2. Person(s) proposing boundary change creates boundary change impact statement and map of area using assessor data.
- 3. On receipt of the boundary change impact statement, map and assessor's data, the QCCIFD Board will set a date for a public hearing on the matter, no sooner than twenty days and no more than 30 days from receipt.
- 4. QCCIFD Board will notify all property owners by first class mail within the proposed annexation area of the date, time and place of the public hearing.
- 5. QCCIFD Board will post and publish notice of hearing as required by law.
- 6. QCCIFD Board will notice the county Board of Supervisors (BOS) for review of impact statement and any necessary changes.

## Proposed CIFD Boundary Change Hearing

- 1. At the public hearing, the QCCIFD Board shall:
  - a. Hear those who appear for or against the proposed boundary change.
  - b. Consider the comments of the BOS.
  - c. Determine whether the proposed boundary change will promote public health, comfort, convenience, necessity or welfare.
- 2. If the QCCIFD Board determines any of the components of item c. above are fulfilled, the Board will authorize the circulation of petitions to authorize the annexation.
- 3. The Clerk of BOS determines property owner signature threshold; requires 50% + 1 of all properties within the proposed annexation, and 50% + 1 of all the property value within the annexation area.
- 4. The Clerk of BOS determines petition form validity.

#### **Boundary Change Petition Circulation**

- 1. Petition circulation -1 year time requirement.
  - a. Petitions required to contain specified information (boundary change impact statement, parcel list, and map).
- 2. Completed petitions are submitted to the Clerk of BOS for signature verification and petition compliance.

#### **Boundary Change Hearing & Order**

- 1. Hearing set after notice received from BOS that threshold signature requirements were met and annexation is authorized.
- 2. QCCIFD public hearing boundary change is completed and proposed area is annexed to the fire district and all property parcels are subject to taxation by QCCIFD to provide services.

**Item 5:** Consideration of district financial matters:

a) Review of monthly financial reports (QCCIFD #25-003):

Administrative Manager Vaughn reviewed the November and December financial reports prepared by the district's C.P.A.; Angela Rath (finance reports included within board packet). Vaughn addressed general questions from the board regarding information contained within the reports.

Motion by Kuefner/ $2^{nd}$  by Doyle: To accept the financial reports as presented; Passed 3-0. (Absent – Ruscetti)

b) Review of invoices/payables and authorization for payment (QCCIFD #25-004):

Vaughn presented invoices (included within board packet) and warrants (checks) for board review and authorization for payment: PolicyLogic, LLC (\$1,722.92); Angela Rath, CPA (\$325), Pinal County Elections (\$200).

Motion by Holthouse/ 2<sup>nd</sup> by Kuefner: To authorize payment of the invoices presented; Passed 3-0. (Absent – Ruscetti)

**Item 6:** Consideration of renewing the district's general liability and associated insurance with VFIS of Arizona (QCCIFD #25-005).

The board received the insurance renewal packet from VFIS. The renewal amount came in at \$79,363. The budgeted amount was \$83,000.

Motion by Kuefner/ 2<sup>nd</sup> by Holthouse To approve the insurance renewal with VFIS and authorize payment for \$79,363; Passed 3-0. (Absent – Ruscetti)
